Annual General Meeting

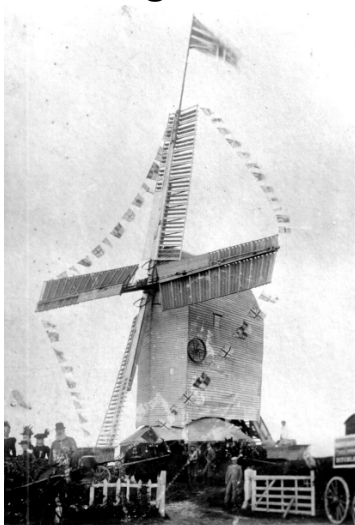
The Annual General Meeting is being held on June 21st 2022 at 7.30pm in the Committee Room, Adastra Hall, Hassocks.
